You will see the 2007 Fishing Regulation Summary selections. For Trout Lake and Joyce Lake regulations, choose "MAP E". Both Trout Lake and Joyce Lake are in Division 31. 2007 information will be updated in a few months.

You can download a copy for printing by right clicking and hit "Save Target As" to your hard drive. If you don't have Adobe Acrobat Reader, download a copy at the M.N.R. site.

We have copies of the "2007 Recreational Fishing Regulations Summary" on Trout Lake and copies are also kept at the Joyce Lake Outpost.

Please do your part to conserve our remote fly-in waters. We Boois & staff urge you to purchase conservation licences.

# Fishing Licences for Sale:

We sell Non-Resident fishing licenses at the lodge. Prices are the same whether you buy from us Boois or in any Ontario licence-selling location.

Save time- have your fishing licences filled in by us when you get to Boois Island on Trout Lake.

Save even more time- have us fill in your fishing licences in advance. There are 2 ways. Prior to your arrival print out the form on page 15. E-mail to tibooi@telus.net, or fax to the lodge at 1 807/727-2489. If the line is busy then fax to our head office at 1 250/468-1467. Another way is, click <a href="http://www.boois.com/fishing-license.htm">http://www.boois.com/fishing-license.htm</a>. You'll find a form to fill in at Booi's site, which will be automatically sent to the lodge. Your licence will be waiting for your signature. Easy as Canadian apple pie.

If link doesn't open, go to our site at <a href="http://www.boois.com">http://www.boois.com</a> then to "Fish Info." 2nd from left, then click on "Fishing Licence".

Need help choosing which type of licence to purchase? The next page is a summary of 4 major non-resident licences that are available. Note: this is a Booi Briefing and subject to change according to the Ontario Fishing Laws that govern Trout Lake and Joyce Lake and Boois own policies.

## 2006 FISHING REGULATIONS (2007 will be updated in a few months)

Pick up your copy of the 2007 Fishing Regulations at the lodge counter or at Joyce Lake Outpost.

The number of fish that you are allowed in possession-daily-this includes your Catch Limit:

> fish in the freezer, in the fridge, on your stringer and also fish eaten each day are included in your daily catch limit. When travelling home you are only allowed to

have your daily limit with you. If you aren't clear on this, please ask us.

Freezing Fish: Each fish packaged for the freezer must be wrapped 1 fish per package, frozen

> flat, with a large patch of skin (at least 2 inches) left on each fillet for identification purposes. Each fish must be labelled with fish specie (e.g. W for Walleye, N for Northern and L.T. for Lake Trout), have the cottage number (e.g. C#5) and also the first initial and last name. (E.G. if John Smith froze a walleye and he stayed

in Cottage 3, his frozen fish would be labelled-

WC#3 Smith.

**Size Limits:** Are the same for both sport fishing and conservation. To measure the fish

accurately, measure from the tip of the nose to the tip of the tail with the lobes

compressed.

Smelt are not allowed Bait Restrictions:

Walleye:

**Catch Limits:** 

Sport Fishing: 4 fish Conservation: 2 fish

Size Limits:

only one fish greater than 18 inches (46 cm)

Pike:

**Catch Limits:** 

Sport Fishing: 4 fish Conservation: 2 fish

Size Limits:

No fish between 27.5 in. and 35.5 inches. (70-90cm) and only one greater than 35.5 in. (90cm)

Booi Island Law in effect for guests, staff & all Booi's, no northern pike are to be kept greater than 27 inches. All pike over this size must be released back into the waters of Trout Lake. Perma-mount trophies, which do not require the dead fish, can be made. These mounts only require a description of the trophy and a picture if you have it. Want more info on perma-mounts? Ask Jim or Tracy. Thank you for doing your part in conserving Trout Lake's trophy pike fishery. It's appreciated and noted. And, of course, like the past 21 years, Joyce Lake is catch and release only, with walleyes less than 18 inches within your conservation limit allowed to be consumed during your stay. Thank you- Joyce Lake remains a top-notch trophy lake because of you.

# **Label Your Baggage:**

# ANY ITEM LOADED INTO THE FLOAT PLANE MUST BE LABELLED WITH YOUR GROUP LEADER'S "RESERVATION" LAST NAME.

EXAMPLE: if John Doe has a group of 5 going to the island on Trout Lake, all 5 of his members will have on all their baggage; DOE- TROUT LAKE

EXAMPLE: if Mary Smith has a group of 3 going to the outpost on Joyce Lake, all 3 of her members will have on all their baggage; SMITH- JOYCE LAKE

Baggage includes tackle boxes, camera bags, toiletry bags, purses, any called "carry on", rod cases, reel cases, boxes of groceries, coolers, suit cases, duffel bags and every other item that is not mentioned that will be loaded into the aircraft.

At Booi's Island, Booi assistants unload all aircraft and deliver all your belongings to your cottage for you. At Joyce Lake Outpost, your pilot will help unload the aircraft.

# Baggage Weight on Float Plane: Applies to <u>Trout Lake</u> Flights and <u>Joyce Lake</u> Flights

You are allowed 100# baggage per person. Baggage includes all luggage, groceries, beer, pop, etc. It includes anything loaded into the airplane, except for your own body weight. Groups over will be charged \$1.50 per pound. For example, if your group of 4 brings a combined baggage weight of 420 pounds, your group will be charged \$1.50 X 20 pounds over= \$30.00 Please don't duplicate and bring along items that we provide for you. Contact Tracy if you have any questions.

# **Commercial Flight Information to Red Lake:**

For commercial airline reservations, we recommend calling Red Lake Travel who find economical fares and also specialize in one-day travel. Call them toll free 1 800 465-3305 from U.S.A. or 1 807 727-2742 from Canada. If you are flying commercially call Tracy and let her know your flight times. She'll coordinate your float plane flights- get you picked up at the airport, and if enough legal daylight-gets you to the float plane base so you can fly to the island on Trout Lake- or to the Outpost on Joyce Lake right away. If you decide to overnight in Red Lake, we can make motel reservations for you and make transportation arrangements to the floatplane base in the morning. (Please see "Overnight accommodation recommendations" on page 12)

#### **Private Aircraft:**

If you're flying your private wheeled aircraft, or your pilot's flying your company jet to the Red Lake Airport, customs clearing information for Red Lake is available at this site. Ctrl. + click to follow link below:

# **Border Crossing:**

Please bring a photo ID (your driver's licence) and your birth certificate. Your drivers licence and birth certificate OR your passport is required to cross the border. If your birth certificate and your driver's licence state different last names (due to marriage etc.) a letter signed by a notary republic stating you are the same person is required. If you have a passport, that will suffice. Please assume that you will be checked.

# 2007 Directions to the Float Plane Base:

We are flying with "Kenora Air Service" who are at the same location as last year. Here's the driving instrucitons:

To reach Kenora Air Service, drive north on Highway 125 until you reach the town of Cochenour. On Edward Road, (look for the Anglican Church sign) make a right turn (you can only turn right) and travel for approximately ¾ of a mile. You will pass the skating rink on your left, there will be some house on your right. Keep going. Soon you will pass the old gold mine site on your left. Keep going a little ways and soon you will glimpse the lake on your left and the airbase. Please keep in mind the highway signs and also the sign at the airbase may still read Red Lake Airways. If you have any questions, or need clarification of your flight times, please do not hesitate to call.

# Overnight Accommodations: Reservations Can Be Made For You

Tracy can make guaranteed reservations for your overnight stay. We personally guarantee all reservations. Tell her your approximate arrival time. The Town of Red Lake is approximately 15 minutes away from the town of Balmertown. Kenora Airways is approx. 5 minutes away from Balmertown.

#### In Red Lake

<u>Howey Bay Motel</u> on Hwy. #105, 807/727-3419, \$80.00 per room for 2, each extra person in room is \$5.00 Tracy can make reservations for you.

Norseman Inn: located on Hwy. #105 807/727-2858, \$75.00 to \$85.00 per room for 2, extra person in room is \$5.00. The newer rooms contain coffee pots.

Red Lake Inn: located on Howey St., 807/727-2161, \$35.00-\$45.00 per room. It is an older style motel so request a bathroom for not all rooms have them. They accept cash only. Tracy can make reservations for you.

#### In Balmertown

<u>Balmer Hotel:</u> Main St., 807/735-2076, \$69.00 - \$85.00 per room for 2, each extra person in room is \$8.00- they have a nice bar/lounge & a restaurant. Let them know you are going to Booi's and ask for a discount.

## The Weather and a Link:

For a great link to check out the weather in the Red Lake Area, go to <a href="http://weather.ec.gc.ca/city/pages/on-104">http://weather.ec.gc.ca/city/pages/on-104</a> metric e.html refresh if it does not show correct date. Trout Lake & Joyce Lake's weather is very similar to Red Lake's. If the weather is 10C, double it and add 30 to find the approximate Fahrenheit temp. (10C X 2 = 20 + 30 = 50F)

# **Payment Options:**

We charge in Canadian Funds. We accept Visa, Master Card and Cash for payments. Deposits are \$350.00 per person, and we recommend using your credit card, just call our toll free number and we'll do it over the phone.

When you use your U.S. Visa or MasterCard, we receive the Canadian amount you owe. Your card company does the conversion for you and on your charge card bill you are simply charged in U.S. Funds. Both Visa and MasterCard are known for their current fair exchange rates. You can call Tracy with your questions.

#### We Can Purchase Your Groceries For You:

Let Booi's do the work- we'll purchase your groceries for your entire stay, your snacks and anything else you wish for. If you think you might be over your 100 pound baggage per person limit, this service will really interest you for any supplies we pick up in advance for you are not included in your weight limit. There is a 25% handling fee charged that is much less expensive than paying the \$1.50 per pound over weight charge. No need to pay now, Tracy will add this to your final bill.
