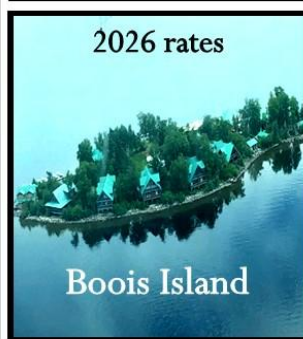

Did You Receive Your Confirmation After You Booked?

After emailing Tracy your requested dates a confirmation is emailed to you. Please read it over & note the deadline to have Tracy receive deposits. It's important to have a deposit for each member of your group whether it be an adult or child. Your flight seats, the number of boats you'll receive, and the size of your cottages are all based on the deposits she receives. Please allow a minimum of 10- 15 days prior to the deadline date for Canada Post is very slow. Be sure to check your reservation dates for accuracy & also check that your group size is accurate.

Deposits Are Needed To Hold Your Reservation

A deposit of \$750.00 USD per person is required to hold your reservation. Please view the [Rate Sheet](#) for details & address to mail a personal or business cheque. Deposits must reach us 3 weeks after the reservation is made or prior to the deadline noted on your confirmation.

When You Write Your Deposit Cheque or Your Final Cheque Upon Check Out



- . Print the amount fully (e.g. not 'five thousand five fifty' or "fifty five hundred fifty" or "fifty five fifty".) The cents portion can be a fraction over /100 or not fraction at all. Do not fraction using X's for the bottom.

- If you already have an Outdoor Card (Is your card invalid? Check the exp. date for it's valid 3 years from purchase) then all you need to purchase is a fishing licence (tag) to complete your licence.
- We Boois urge you to easily purchase your fishing licence online. You can save the licence (tag) and outdoor card to your phone.
- If you wish a hard copy instead, we recommended purchasing at least 6 weeks prior. Your Outdoor card will arrive in the mail prior your Booi Trip. Simply purchase a Fishing Licence (tag), print, and bring with.

2026 Fishing Regulations

Note: this is a Booi Briefing and subject to change according to the Ontario Fishing Laws that govern Trout Lake and Boois own policies. If in doubt, always follow the MNR laws. These are the regulations as of 0114 2026 & will be updated when the information is provided.

Catch Limit The number of fish that you are allowed in possession- daily- this includes your fish in the freezer, in the fridge, on your stringer and fish eaten each day. These are all included in your daily catch limit count. When travelling home you are only allowed to have your daily limit with you. If you aren't clear on this, please ask us.

Freezing Fish Each fish packaged for the freezer must be wrapped

- 1 fish per package- frozen flat
- with a patch of skin (at least 2 inches) left on each fillet for identification purposes
- each fish must be labelled with the fish species (e.g. W for walleye, N for northern and L.T. for lake trout)
- have the cottage number (e.g., C #5)
- the first initial and last name. (e.g., if John Smith froze a walleye and he stayed in cottage 3, his frozen fish would be labelled- WC#3 J. Smith).

Size Limits Are the same for both sport fishing and conservation. To measure the fish accurately measure from the tip of the nose to the tip of the tail with the lobes compressed.

Lake Trout	01.01 thru 09.30	2	1	Only 1 over 22"(56 cm) for C no size limit
Pike	Open all year	4	2	No fish between 27.5 -35.5" (70-90 cm) and only 1 greater than 35.5"(90 cm)

Booi Island Law in effect for guests, staff & all Boois, no northern pike are to be kept greater than 27 inches. All pike over this size must be released back into the waters of Trout Lake. Replica-mount trophies which do not require the dead fish can be made. These mounts only require a description of the trophy and a picture if you have it. Thank you for doing your part in conserving Trout Lake's trophy pike fishery. It's appreciated and noted.

Information: Personal Groceries Exempt from Tariffs

Tariffs will NOT be applied to personal items including consumable items brought into Canada by non-resident visitors. As long as the amount of grocery items is "appropriate for their needs and consistent with the purpose, nature and duration of their intended stay in Canada" no tariffs will be applied on USA products.

Food limits will continue to apply as always for dairy and meat products as set out by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA).

Label Your Baggage

Every item loaded into the plane must be labelled (use duct or masking tape) with

- ✿ Last Name the reservation is under
- ✿ Boois
- ✿ *You can also add your own last name too if there's room.*

Baggage includes tackle boxes, camera bags, toiletry bags, purses, any called "carry on", rod cases, reel cases, boxes of groceries, coolers, suitcases, duffel bags and every other item that is not mentioned that will be loaded into the aircraft. Just simply use masking tape & a marker.

At Boois Island, Booi assistants unload all aircraft and deliver all your belongings to your cottage for you.

Baggage Weight on Float Plane

Strictly Enforced in 2026

Groups over will be charged \$2.50 per pound.

You are allowed 100 pounds of baggage per person. Baggage includes all luggage, groceries, beer, pop, etc. It includes anything loaded into the airplane- except for your own body weight. For example, if your group of 4 brings a combined baggage weight of 420 pounds, your group will be charged $\$2.50 \times 20$ pounds over = \$50.00 Please avoid duplicating items- meet with your group to determine who is bringing what and go over the list of items that is included in your stay that we provide for you. Email Tracy if you have any questions.

For commercial airline reservations, we recommend visiting [Red Lake Travel](#) who'll find economical fares and they specialize in one-day travel. Call them toll free 1 800 465-3305 from U.S.A. or 1 807 727-2742 from Canada. If you are flying commercially, please email Tracy and let her know your flight times. If you decide to overnight in Red Lake, please make reservations in advance. Let Tracy know where you'll be staying in case there are last minute changes to flight times and if you need help with transportation arrangements to the plane base. Private Aircraft

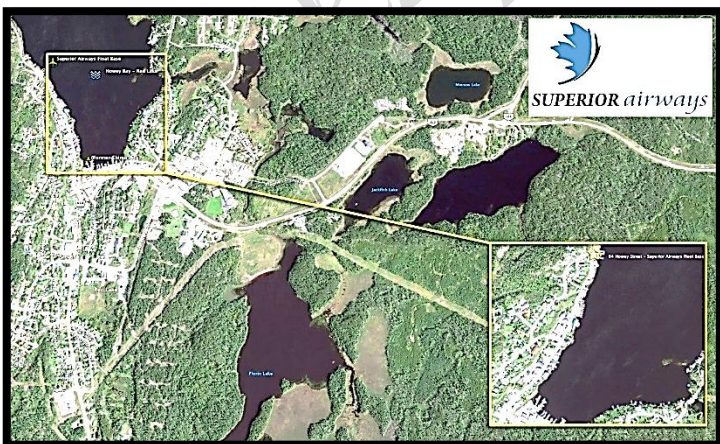
If you're flying your private wheeled aircraft, or your pilot's flying your company jet to the [Red Lake Airport](#), here is the CANPASS site for more information. [CANPASS \(cbsa-asfc.gc.ca\)](#) Note that you cannot clear customs at Red Lake.

Directions to Superior Airways Water Base- in Red Lake- same location since 2019

There's no airport fees and no charge for parking. The aircraft flown are Cessna Caravans/ 9 passenger Amphibian, Beavers, and Turbine Otters. Superior Airways has 2 locations- wheels & floats- we use the float location located in the town of Red Lake.

The address is 68 Howey St. in Red Lake, Ontario

If using Google Maps- search for Superior Airways in Red Lake, Ontario



You must be at Superior Airways Float Base prior 6:30 AM on your scheduled day of arrival, *unless prior arrangements have been made with Tracy.*

Please keep your baggage/grocery weight to 100 lb. per person. If your group combined is over the 100 lb. limit per person a charge will appear on your final Booi bill.

Overnight Accommodations in Town

The town of Red Lake is approximately 15 minutes from the town of Balmertown- a very easy drive. Superior Airways Float Plane Base is in Red Lake.

We Can Purchase Your Groceries for You

Let Boois do the work- we'll purchase your groceries for your entire stay, your snacks, and anything else you wish. If you think you might be over your 100-pound baggage per person limit, this service will really interest you for any supplies we pick up in advance for you are not included in your weight limit.

There is a 30% handling fee charged that is probably less expensive than paying the \$2.50 per pound overweight charge. Please keep in mind that groceries, beer & alcohol is expensive in Red Lake. Create your grocery list, email it to Tracy and we'll do the rest. You do not need a form; just list the items you desire in your email. If you need a list for ideas on what to order, just email Tracy. We Do Not Sell Live Bait

On the island we do not sell live bait, nor do we purchase it for you.

Live Bait Can't Be Taken Across The Border

Canada Service Border Agency (CBSA) does not allow any bait (worms, minnows-live or dead, and leeches) into Canada.

If you wish to fish with live bait you must purchase live bait and leeches from a bait shop (a commercial licence holder) in the Bait Management Zone (BMZ) where you are fishing. **We are BMZ 4.**

When purchasing your live bait make sure your receipt states (Conservation Officers are currently looking for baitfish receipts from anglers. This is part of the new regulations.).

- date of purchase
- business name (if applicable)
- commercial licence number
- location of purchase
- quantity of bait purchased

You must use or dispose of your baitfish or leeches (dead or alive) within 2 weeks of purchasing them.

- Flutter spoons
- 4 oz. inline chain sinkers
- Little Cleos
- Various spoons
- Williams Wobblers

Walleye

- 3/8 oz. walking sinkers
- Jig heads- various colours
- Twister tails- various colours

Pike

- Red & white Dare Devils
- 5 of Diamonds
- Huskie Jerks 4" or 5"
- Shadow Wraps
- Mepps spinners- size 4-5

Trout & Walleye

- Bucktail Jigs- blue or white- 2 oz.
- Snaps & swivels- mdm.
- Snail hooks- #6

Summer Lure Suggestions

Walleye

- 1/2 oz. jigs/white, chartreuse, pink
- Little Joes/gold, silver or chartreuse
- Twister Tails/white, yellow, chartreuse- sometimes tipped with a crawler or a leech
- Shad Raps/deep runner, black/silver, perch
- Little Joes or Lindy Rigs

Northern

- Suicks/small & big
- Johnson's silver minnow/big silver, small & lg. gold
- Chain swivel sinkers
- Spinners/Mepps #5 blade, fairly large, chartreuse on gold, gold or red on silver
- 5 of Diamonds
- Daredevils/black and white
- Rattling Raps/perch or silver in colour

With walleye and pike sometimes bright colours on bright days and dark colours on dark days works.

Lake Trout

- Buck tail jigs/big 1 1/2 oz. or 2 oz. white or chartreuse, sometimes any colour works
- Dr. spoons/4" rubber minnows/big blue & white with big jig head
- 5 of Diamonds
- Sutton Spoons
- Shad Raps/ big sized silver

Recommended Line

- Walleye- 8lb. test
- Lake Trout- 17 lb. test
- Northern- 12 lb. test
